

Visitors have free, daily access to the Eagle's Stage on Mount Ahorn from mid-June to October (except Tuesdays and Wednesdays) between 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 p.m., where they can visit the falconers with their Birds of Prey.

At the Birds of Prey Show, which takes place daily (except Tuesdays) at 02.00 p.m., up to 800 «cinema-goers» can experience the majestic aerial acrobats in action and, in addition to the impressive flight manoeuvres, discover exciting information about the habits of these feathered wild animals. A show of this kind at such close quarters is way better than any evening at the cinema.





### PENKEN PEPI AT PENKENJOCH

Not far from the Penkenjoch Reservoir with its impressive Garnet Chapel, the 8-metre tall wooden bear, Penken Pepi, welcomes visitors of every age. The ultimate playground for all children is housed inside the giant Pepi. It is said that Penken Pepi was a toy belonging to the legendary Tux Giant, who may have left it behind on the Penkenjoch when he fled from the Zillertal valley.



### WHERE EVERY BIKER'S HEART WILL SKIP A BEAT

Mountain bikers are also well catered for on Mount Penken, whether on an e-bike, under their own steam, or conveniently with gondola bike transport. Several routes in various degrees of difficulty for experts and aspiring pros whet the appetite and motivate. Scenic pleasure cycling or speeding up and downhill until your "calves burn"? It's each to their own when it comes to biking preferences!



### TIP 1: RASTKOGEL HUT NO. 420

The tour starts at the Penkenbahn mountain station in the direction of the Penkenjoch. Shortly after the bottom station of the Kombibahn Penken, a gravel path leads down into the Horbergtal valley on the right-hand side, past the Horbergbahn to the Hochschwendberg. Once you reach the valley station of the Möslbahn, the path leads uphill to the left. Shortly after the tree line you reach the toll station of the Zillertaler Höhenstrasse. This is where the circular route Rastkogel Hut No. 420 begins, from which you reach the Rastkogel Hut via the Schaftenheualm and Sidanalm. Experienced bikers can also continue on to the Sidanjoch viewpoint. From there you return to the starting point at the toll station. Then the tour takes you down to Hippach via the Schwendbergstraße. From there you can return to Mayrhofen via the Zillertal cycle path.

- Route length: 36 km • Level of difficulty: difficult
- Altitude difference uphill / downhill: 1.387 m/2.531 m

### **TIP 2: BRINDLINGALM NO. 421**

The tour starts at the Penkenbahn mountain station in the direction of the Penkenjoch. Shortly after the bottom station of the Kombibahn Penken, a gravel path leads down into the Horbergtal valley on the right-hand side, past the Horbergbahn to the Hochschwendberg. Once you reach the valley station of the Möslbahn, the path leads uphill to the left. After a short ride you reach the Brindlingalm turnoff, where you follow bike trail no. 421 through the forest to the Nasenalm snack station (1,700 m) and further on to the Brindlingalm snack station (1,823 m). Back to the Möslbahn valley station. From here the Schwendbergstrasse takes you down to Hippach. Once there you can return to Mayrhofen via the Zillertal cycle path. • Route length: 28 km

Altitude difference uphill / downhill: 861 m / 2,004 m



# LEISURE TRAIL AHORN DURATION: 1 H, EASY

The trail runs via the Eagle's View and Zillertal 2.500 ma.s.l. ViewingPlatforms to the idyllic Lake AhornSee and on 2.000 m a.s.l. to the Stilluptal and Filzenalm ViewingPlatforms. The view from here over the central Zillertal Alps is simply sensational. You can then continue hiking in the direction of the Eagle's Stage Ahorn and FalknerOase.

**DURATION: 2 H, MODERATE** 

The Path **No. 42a** to the Filzenkogel offers an easy summit tour. The ascent is rewarded with breathtaking views – and don't forget to put your name in the summit book! Time indication for the round trip.



# PANORAMA TRAIL PENKEN DURATION: 1 H, EASY

Ascent via Path No. 22. Then turn right onto Path 2,500 m a.s.l. No. 22a just after the valley station of the Kombibahn 2.000 m a.s.l. Penken. Here you will pass several viewing stations. At the end of the path you can either continue uphill or else return to your point of departure.

Hike from the mountain station of Penkenbahn to the 2.500 m ü.NN middle station of the Finkenberger Almbahnen. Idyllic 2.000 m ü. NN landscapes and magnificent views of Mount Ahorn opposite and the Stilluptal Valley can be enjoyed along the newly constructed BergWaldWeg. Our tip: 1.000 m ü.NN take advantage of the Penkenjoch Lopp Hike Ticket to 500 m ü.NN comfortably ride up to Penkenjoch and hike back.

Follow Path **No. 24** via Horbergtal into Sidantal. A brief <sup>2,500 m a.s.l.</sup> detour to Schiestl's Sunnalm is possible. From here it is 2,000 m a.s.l. approx. 1 hour to the valley station of Möslbahn (operated only in winter). Back to Mayrhofen with the bus via Schwendberg and Hippach.
